

National Chung Cheng University Dormitory Network Application and Network Configuration Guide (Spring 2017 ~)



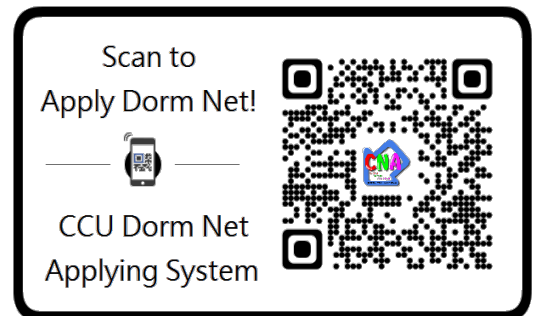
I. Preparation

Please make sure you have the following equipment and have installed them appropriately.

1. Ethernet adapter (for computer w/o Internet port)
2. UTP network cable (cat. 5e or higher category)

II. Application Process

1. Go to <https://www.dorm.ccu.edu.tw/student/> .
(Click “English” version on the upper right corner)
2. Fill in your student ID and then click “Submit”.
3. Select period (Semester, Winter/Summer Vacation or Short-Term) and click “Apply Now”.
4. Fill in your MAC address. (If you do not know how to, you may refer to **Part III**)
5. Complete required information and click “Submit”.
6. Application is now finished and the Internet should be available in 30 to 60 minutes.
7. Printout “Payment Form”, printed by laser jet is recommended. (Refer to **Part IV**)



III. Finding My MAC Address

1. Windows XP/Vista/7/8
 - i. Press **Windows key + R** and type **cmd**.
 - ii. At the command prompt, type **getmac /v** and press Enter.
 - iii. Look for **Physical Address** under Ethernet adapter Local Area Connection section.
2. Mac OS X
 - i. Go to **System Preferences**.
 - ii. Click on **Network** and then select **(Thunderbolt/USB) Ethernet** in the left column.
 - iii. Click on **Advanced**, select **Hardware** tab. Look for **MAC address**

MAC address should be in the form of “0B-16-76-7D-BC-C2”. (In both letter cases are correct)

Note that “0” in mac address is “zero” rather than capital “O” nor lower case “o”!

IV. Network Fee

1. Fall Semester (Winter Vacation Included)
NT. 1000 per person before December 1st (excluded), and NT. 500 per person after then.
2. Spring Semester (Summer Vacation Included)
NT. 1000 per person before May 16th (excluded), and NT. 500 per person after then.
3. Winter / Summer Vacation (**Only for those who did not apply network for semester**)
W: NT.250. S: NT. 500 before August 1st (excluded), NT. 250 per person after then.
4. Short-Term
Contact dormitory network office. (Refer to **Part VI**)

*Bring **Payment Form***, **Fee** and **Student ID Card** to Office 219, 2F, Computer Center.*

*(*Payment Form: the page that shows after application finished)*

5. Refund (For Students Moving out Dormitory or Any Reason[#])

For those who paid NT. 1000, in the beginning month of semester, you will receive a refund of three quarters (NT. 750);

after then you will receive a refund of one half (NT. 500). After December 1st (for fall semester) or May 16th (for spring semester), you will not receive any refund.

For those who paid NT. 500 and NT. 250, you will not receive any refund.

Bring Receipt of Payment and Student ID Card to Office 219, 2F, Computer Center.

([#]There is no refund due to permanent suspension by Network Administrator for violation!)

V. Regulation & Policy

1. Each student is allowed to upload and download up to **10GB** capacity per day.

Inter-campus activities (with IP address 140.123.*.*) will not be included.

2. Violator of traffic limitations (Refer to **V.1**) will be subjected to network suspension.

Time	Suspension Period
1 st / 2 nd	Suspended for one day from application of recovery
Third	Suspended for two days from application of recovery
Fourth	Suspended for three days from application of recovery
... And so on. (Up to seven-day suspension)	

3. Cyber attack or spamming due to computer virus infection or ill intent will lead to network suspension and possible violation of Criminal Code.

Time	Suspension Period
1 st / 2 nd	Suspended for one day from application of recovery
Third	Suspended for two days from application of recovery
Fourth	Suspended for three days from application of recovery
... And so on. (Up to fourteen-day suspension)	

4. Violator of Copyright Act will be subjected to **four-week** suspension and is required to sign a written guarantee stating that such conduct will never occur again. Shall there be breach of guarantee in future, violator will be **permanently** suspended for the rest of semester.

5. Personal wireless router and wireless access point are prohibited.
(Not include personal mobile data connection, such as 3G/LTE/GPRS)

6. Notice that if there is any inconsistency or ambiguity between the English version and the Chinese version, the Chinese version shall prevail.

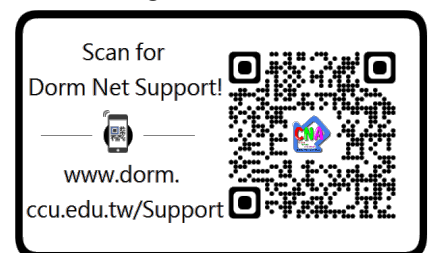
